- 85.0.01 INTERNATIONAL BOIOTIAN CONFERENCE IN HONOUR OF THE 75th BIRTHDAY OF PROFESSOR DR. SIEGFRIED LAUFFER

The Institut für Alte Geschichte of the University of Munich announces an International Boiotian Conference to honour the 75th birthday of Professor Dr. Siegfried LAUFFER in 1986. Organized by Dr. Hartmut Beister, with the support of Professor M. Wörkle, Director of the Kommission für Alte Geschichte und Epigraphik, and Professor John Buckler, University of Illinois, the Colloquium is intended as a Jubileum for Professor Lauffer, whose primary work has been devoted to Boiotian history and epigraphy. The Colloquium will be held in Munich from 13-17 June 1986. Those interested in presenting papers are invited to send resumés of their topics (no longer than four typed pages) to Dr. Beister at their earliest convenience. The organizers reserve the right to make the final selection of papers from those submitted and to limit the length of oral presentations. The collected papers are to be published as a SUPPLEMENT of TEIRESIAS.
